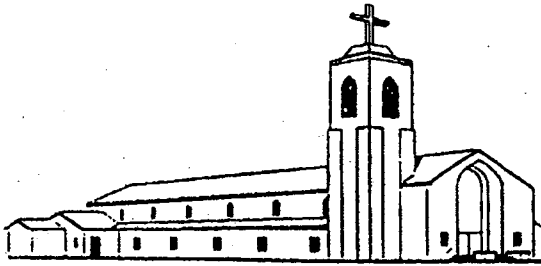

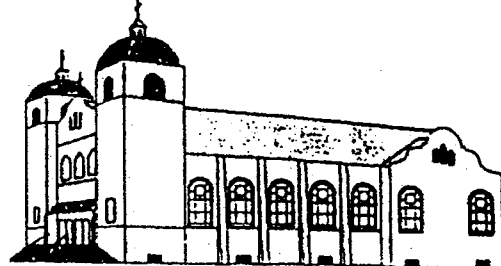

The Knights of Columbus will have a food drive honoring St. Joseph, Provider & Protector of the Holy Family, the weekend of March 22 & 23 after all masses. St. Anthony's Pantry needs donations of non-perishable food: Canned meat, peanut butter, canned/ dried beans (any kind), pasta & sauce, canned fruit & vegetables, rice & soups.

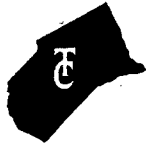
