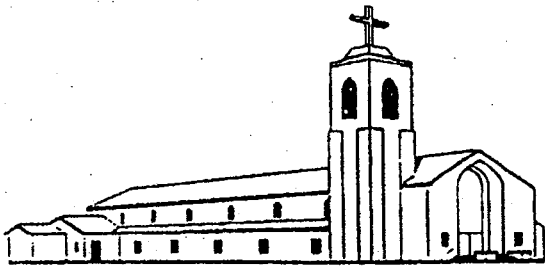

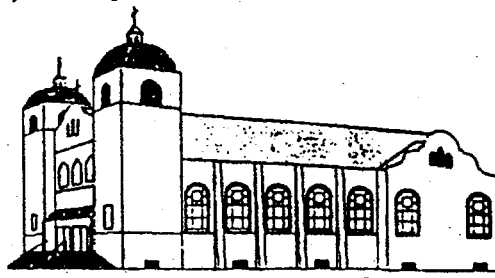

**Bishop Brennan's Annual Charity
Event & Mass March 22 & 23, 2025**

Each Lenten season, Bishop Joseph Brennan invites the faithful across the Diocese to partake in St. Joseph's Table, a Catholic tradition he holds dear. This tradition is especially significant to him because of his Italian heritage, his birth name, & its close connection to his birthday. The centuries old tradition of St. Joseph's table celebrates the charity of St. Joseph by inviting people to bring food for those facing food and housing insecurity. Bishop Brennan invites the parishes of the Diocese of Fresno to join him in celebrating St. Joseph's Table at all weekend Masses of March 22nd and March 23rd. Each parish community is encouraged to bring non-perishable foods to a 'table' honoring St. Joseph, which will be delivered to local food banks, pantries, & charitable organizations providing food to the poor. If assistance is needed from parishes, The Knights of Columbus or Catholic Charities are available to assist. The Knights of Columbus will have a food drive honoring St. Joseph, Provider & Protector of the Holy Family, the weekend of March 22 & 23 after all masses. St. Anthony's Pantry needs donations of non-perishable food: Canned meat, peanut butter, canned/ dried beans (any kind), pasta & sauce, canned fruit & vegetables, rice & soups.

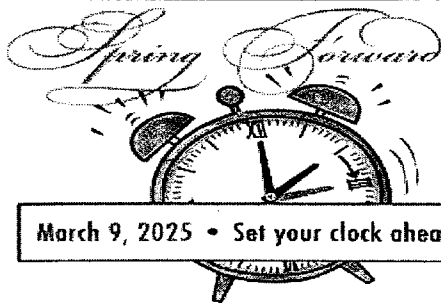

Fast & Abstinence (USCCB)

Ash Wednesday & Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting & abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one (1) full meal, as well as two (2) smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards. Members of the Eastern Catholic Churches are to observe the particular law of their own *sui iuris* Church. If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering & death of the Lord Jesus & to prepare ourselves to share more fully & to celebrate more readily his Resurrection.

Ayuno y abstinencia (USCCB)

El Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo son días obligatorios de ayuno y abstinencia para los católicos. Además, los viernes durante la Cuaresma son días obligatorios de abstinencia. Para los miembros de la Iglesia Católica Latina, las normas sobre el ayuno son obligatorias desde los 18 años hasta los 59 años. Cuando se ayuna, se permite a una persona comer una (1) comida completa, así como dos (2) comidas más pequeñas que juntas no sean iguales a una comida completa. Las normas sobre la abstinencia de carne son vinculantes para los miembros de la Iglesia Católica Latina a partir de los 14 años. Los miembros de las Iglesias Católicas Orientales deben observar la ley particular de su propia Iglesia *sui iuris*. Si es posible, el ayuno del Viernes Santo se continúa hasta la Vigilia Pascual (la noche del Sábado Santo) como el "ayuno pascual" para honrar el sufrimiento y la muerte del Señor Jesús y para prepararnos para compartir más plenamente y celebrar más fácilmente su Resurrección.
