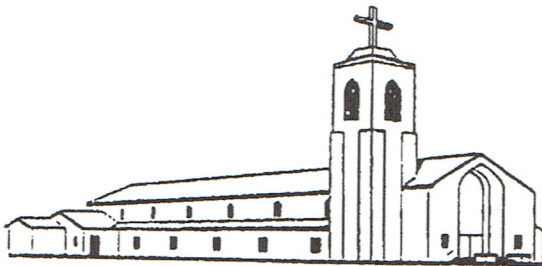

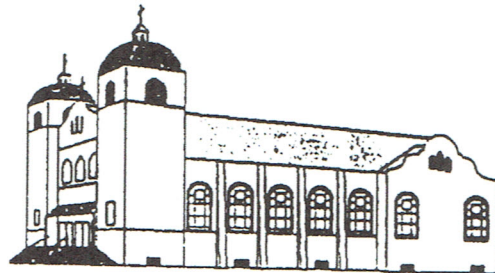

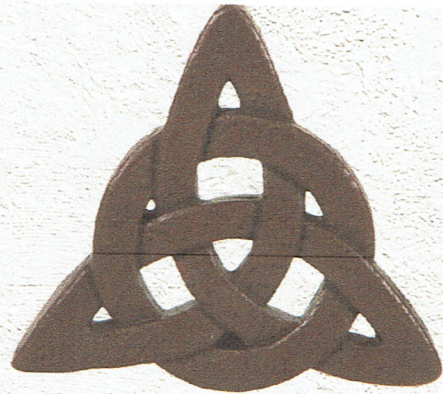

## THE MYSTERY OF THE HOLY TRINITY

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. We say these words as we make the sign of the cross, the sign of God's saving love for us in Jesus Christ through the power of the Holy Spirit. God who created the heavens, earth, and all who dwell in it. Jesus Christ, through whom we are offered salvation and peace. The Holy Spirit, who breathes life, leads us to the truth, and strengthens us to live as God's holy people. On this Solemnity, let us pause to reflect upon the mystery of the Holy Trinity, three persons in one God. As we name the mystery, may we come to know God's love more deeply and live it more profoundly.

### PERCEIVE WHAT CANNOT BE SEEN

Have you ever paused on a clear night to look up at the stars, or taken time to notice the splendor of spring flowers, the changing colors of the autumn leaves, or the still beauty of a snow-covered landscape? Such moments of quiet reflection may lead us to a powerful sense of wonder. The same God who created the stars, flowers, trees, and snow created each of us. In sensing God's presence in the beauty that surrounds us, we may be filled with awe in perceiving what cannot be seen. Moments of wonder and awe may take us by surprise. It may be invisible, yet in these moments we see the hand of God.

### LOOK WITH EYES OF FAITH

Not only in the beauty of God's creation do we sense the presence of the Lord. In times of prayer, especially the celebration of the Eucharist, we are strengthened in faith to be assured of the mystery of the triune God. The Holy Spirit guides us to the truth—the truth of who God is and who we are in God's sight. Even in times of great trial, we endure and find hope in the mystery of Christ's love—Jesus, who gave his life for us on the cross and who rose in glory is with us in times of wonder and in moments of difficulty. We see the love of God in the acts of love of others and when we act as Christ's people in service and care for others. We grow in the capacity to see with the eyes of faith, eyes that recognize God's grace and are ready to respond by sharing the love of God, Father, Son, and Spirit, in the world.

### BIBLICAL ROOTS OF THE TRINITY

Today's readings show some biblical roots of what Christians would later call the Trinity. Proverbs showcases the role of Wisdom in the work of creation, portrayed as a reality outside of God but integrated into God's work of forming the heavens and the earth. We join the psalmist in sharing Wisdom's delight in God's handiwork: "O Lord, our God, how wonderful your name in all the earth" (Psalm 8:2). In his letter to the Romans, Paul writes of peace with God through Jesus, and the love of God received through the Holy Spirit, distinguishing God, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit while also displaying their abiding unity. Finally, in the farewell discourse from John's Gospel, Jesus—who had earlier spoken of himself as Son of the Father—promises his friends that they will receive the Spirit of truth that will teach and guide them after his departure. 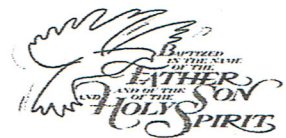

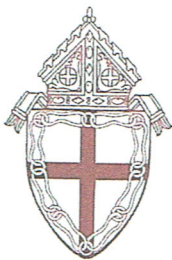

### AN OPEN LETTER TO MY PRIESTS, DEACONS, SEMINARIANS AND ALL THE FAITHFUL OF THE DIOCESE OF FRESNO

#### IN SUPPORT OF ARCHBISHOP CORDILEONE

Published on June 6, 2022, Feast of The Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church

Events in our lives tend to take on a life of their own and they can certainly outpace our responses too. Lord knows we have been through a lot as a nation, as a people of faith, as a Church and, simply, as humans who are hurting when others are hurting, like those moms and dads in Uvalde, Texas. So, my responses to other *events* in our lives have been a bit tardy, to say the least.

Brothers and sisters, I have been wanting to write in support of Archbishop Cordileone for several weeks now. He has taken a lot of heat, in and out of the Church, for standing up for what's right. Of course, I am referring to his recent statement prohibiting Nancy Pelosi, the current Speaker of the House in Congress, from receiving Communion, the Holy Eucharist, in the Archdiocese of San Francisco. He chose this course of action for her persistent stand in support of abortion and for her recent participation in an effort to *codify* into Federal law the right to take the life of an innocent, unborn child so as to enshrine that right in the law of the land. The Archbishop has done his due diligence and has made consistent attempts for a number of years to communicate with the Speaker about authentic Church teaching in this regard. In other words, like a good pastor, he is trying to lead her away from a very sinful situation. He is caring for her soul.

Speaking of sinfulness and care of souls, you may have heard about an entertainer who recently weighed in on this whole subject. In case you missed her statement which was aired on a show called 'The View', she took exception to the Archbishop's public announcement regarding Speaker Pelosi's prohibition from receiving Holy Communion. Here is part of what she said:

*"This is not your job, dude! That is not up to you to make that decision...What is the point of Communion, right? It's for sinners. It's the reward of saints, but the bread of sinners. How dare you!"*

Where do I begin? Let's begin with the Archbishop's *job*. It is his job to teach, to correct, to admonish and, if necessary, to impose sanctions. It is his job (everyone's job in fact) to point things out to and charitably correct anyone who is in a sinful situation. That is even more important to do when the person and the situation are so public, persistent, and brazen. Although it is not the Archbishop's job to make the decision for her - to receive Communion or not - it is his job to make every effort to properly form her conscience. It is Nancy's *job* to decide to refrain from taking Holy Communion until such time as she is reconciled to Church teaching about the unborn and until such time as she desists in publicly promoting and advocating the protection and expansion of abortion and abortion rights.



There is actually one thing that I agreed with when the aforementioned entertainer said, "What's the point of Communion, right? It's for sinners." Precisely! Yes, Communion is not a reward for good behavior. It is not anything that we are entitled to in any way, shape, or form. Nobody is entitled to receive! That is why everyone (including the priest or presiding bishop) prays right before receiving Communion, "Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed." Yes, Eucharist is medicine for the sin-sick soul.

Something essential is missing in all this. The problem I have with most abortion-promoting Catholic politicians is that they do not seem to be acknowledging the sin in any of this. Even if they somehow acknowledge the sin in the depth of their soul and their conscience as they approach the Eucharist, something which only they and God can know, they cannot publicly persist in the sin. In the Sacrament of Penance, for example, there must be a component on the part of the penitent which we call the 'firm purpose of amendment'. That component is very clear in part of the Act of Contrition which I memorized in Second Grade which declares, "I firmly resolve, with the help of Thy grace, to sin no more and to avoid the near occasion of sin." So, returning to the matter at hand, the same principle applies. If you are going up to receive Communion and have no intention of changing your heart, mind, and actions regarding these teachings, then you should make the decision not to receive Communion. Otherwise, someone may have to impose the sanction on you. Ironic, is it not? A 'Pro Choice' person leaving you no choice!

You see, some Catholic politicians seem to be approaching the Eucharist as a 'virtue signaling' moment. Some would turn that moment into a public ("Hey, look at me!") demonstration of their Catholic credentials and a kind of spiritual 'photo op'. There is more than enough hypocrisy to go around these days – in my own life too – but it takes some kind of immense spiritual hubris and hypocrisy to waltz up for Communion while at the same time publicly ignoring and positively working against essential Church teaching and practice, much less promoting something that is intrinsically evil.

Again, brothers and sisters, I publicly state my support for Archbishop Cordileone for his decision and pronouncement regarding the Speaker of the House. It is personally challenging, as it should be to every bishop in this beautiful country of ours, as this encourages all of us to engage in the same kind of dialogue with Catholic politicians in our own jurisdictions about these very same issues. That takes time, effort, and courage. Please pray for me that the Spirit will bless my ministry here in the Diocese of Fresno with all of that and - dare I say - even more, that I might be a better shepherd of souls for you and with you.

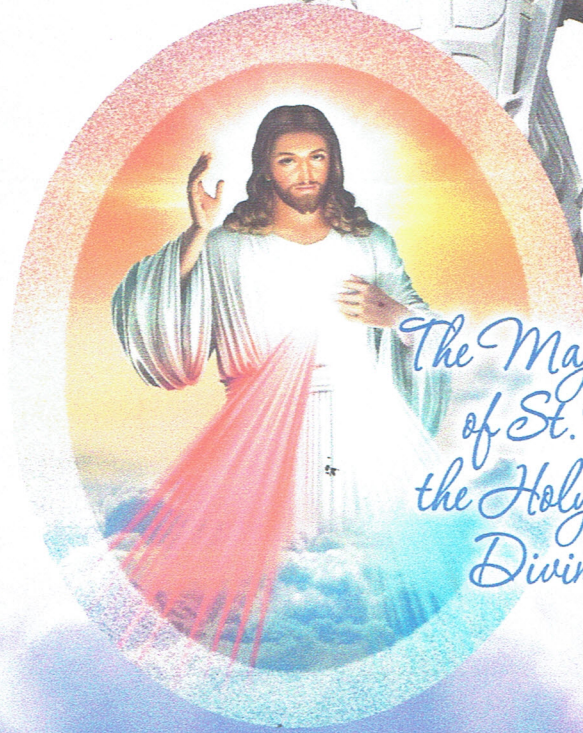
